The Fair Oaks Ranch Police Department is encouraging young people of our community the opportunity to experience law enforcement first hand. The **Fair Oaks Ranch Police Department Junior Police Academy** will hold one (1) week session in the summer of **2019 and is FREE to our Students**. Students will learn the basic functions of a working police department as well as have a chance to explore the idea of a possible career in this ever challenging and demanding field.

Students will attend classes with topics including, but not limited to, Texas law, patrol procedures, traffic enforcement, and many other areas of law enforcement. Students will have the opportunity to practice what they learn in practical exercises.

The Academy will be one (1) week long and will be Monday thru Friday 8:30 am – 4:00 pm. The Academy will be held at the Fair Oaks Ranch Police Dept. located at 7286 Dietz Elkhorn Rd.

Students will have several breaks throughout the day as needed. This application will include a medical release, and parental consent forms.

Students will be expected to take the program seriously, and follow academy rules, which closely resemble school rules.

Due to the seriousness of the content of this program, immature behavior will not be tolerated and students failing to comply with behavior expectations may be removed from the academy.

Students will be chosen in the order that all paperwork is received. We will provide a mid-morning snack, lunch and an afternoon snack.
