Deferred Disposition

Deferred disposition is a process in which the judge requires the defendant to adhere to certain terms. If you choose this option you will be on probation for a period of up to 180 days depending on violation. If a defendant successfully completes those terms, the case will be dismissed. Terms may include, but are not limited to, refraining from committing certain violations during a specified time period, attending a defensive driving class, or completing a specified number of community service hours. If the defendant does not complete the terms of deferred disposition or attend educational classes, and additional fine will be imposed and a conviction entered on their driving record.

Deferred Disposition Minimum Qualifications:

- Must be 17 years or older
- Enter a plea (no contest or guilty)
- Must pay total amount of citation. Plus a \$40 Special Expense Fee.

Deferred disposition may be requested in person, mail or email(court@fairoaksranchtx.org). You are required to submit the Deferred Request Form with a plea form, copy of TX drivers license & current proof insurance. All available forms can be located in court forms section in the court website.

In your form, please make sure you fill out completely and submit with additional documents requested. If you wish to request deferred disposition, in person or mail in your request to the following address:

You are not required to send payment with your request for deferred disposition. If your request is granted, the court will send a reply by mail or email including the deferred disposition order with amount due, due date and any other conditions.

Not all citation and/or violations qualify for deferred disposition. Please contact the court if you have any questions after reviewing the online information available.

(Juveniles do not qualify for any options with the clerks, all juveniles must appear to a hearing with the presiding judge with a parent present.
